

Geosciences - GEOS (B.S.)

The following program of study is recommended for students who plan to transfer to the College of Science to earn a Bachelor of Science, Major - Geosciences (GEOS).

Prospective Geoscience majors may take Physical Geology and Historical Geology courses (GOL 105, GOL 106) at the community college to fulfill the GEOS 2024 requirement. However, all Geosciences majors who have taken Physical Geology and Historical Geology courses are still encouraged to take GEOS 2024 Earth's Dynamic Systems for a more integrated experience at Virginia Tech.
